The Hidden Agenda Behind Net Zero: A Threat to Freedom and Individual Rights

This process has devastating consequences, with small and medium-sized food producers being pushed out of the market. In their place, high-tech food companies, in which Gates holds significant investments, are capitalizing on the vacuum, promoting a future of "farming without farmers" and "food without farms."

The consolidation of power raises concerns about food security, economic disparity, and the erosion of agricultural traditions.

Furthermore, the net zero agenda extends its reach into the personal lives of individuals. 

Excerpts from the U.N.'s 2030 Agenda Declaration

"We resolve, between now and 2030, to end poverty and hunger everywhere; to combat inequalities within and among countries; to build peaceful, just and inclusive societies; to protect human rights and promote gender equality and the empowerment of women and girls; and to ensure the lasting protection of the planet and its natural resources... As we embark on this great collective journey, we pledge that no one will be left behind... This is an Agenda of unprecedented scope and significance. It is accepted by all countries and is applicable to all... In these Goals and targets, we are setting out a supremely ambitious and transformational vision... We will implement the Agenda for the full benefit of all... In doing so, we reaffirm our commitment to international law and emphasize that the Agenda is to be implemented in a manner that is consistent with the rights and obligations of states under international law."

The Battle to Kill the Kill Switch By Terri Hall

Earlier this month, House Republicans failed to defund a federal "kill switch" mandate, which will require all vehicles produced in 2026 and beyond to feature technology that can remotely disable the vehicle if police "detect impairment." Texans Uniting for Reform and Freedom (TURF) Founder and Director Terri Hall shares her reflections.

Rep. Thomas Massie gave a valiant effort to add our kill switch amendment to the Transportation, Housing and Urban Development (THUD) appropriations bill in the U.S. House. We came very close: just 28 votes shy. His floor speech was spot on. It's hard to believe this isn't some kind of science fiction movie, but sadly it's become reality under the Biden Administration's law that few even read or vetted before it passed.

Apparently one group, MADD (Mother's Against Drunk Driving), stopped our amendment from passing even though it's something literally hundreds of groups in Texas alone support, as well as Heritage Action, National Motorists Association and Citizens for Renewing America. This isn't about drunk driving. Mandating this technology be put into every vehicle is an unconstitutional surveillance of Americans that violates our 4th Amendment rights.

We hope, through the questions posed to Secretary Pete Buttigieg in our letter authored by Rep. Scott Perry (R-PA, Chair of Freedom Caucus), to get more details that will help us pull the plug on this dangerous technology being put into every American's vehicle. Congress must step in to protect our basic liberties from the long, overreaching arm of Big Government. We'll continue to step-up our efforts to educate more Americans and members of Congress about the threats this technology poses to our constitutional rights. This fight certainly isn't over.
