So many candidates applied to get vetted, in fact, that we are still working on our own organization's endorsement list.

Vetting is something we take very seriously, and there are several reasons why we might choose not to endorse in a given race. There may be only slight differences between candidates, or perhaps we aren't comfortable enough to grant a candidate an Eagle Forum endorsement. Some candidates aren't ready or informed enough to assume an elected position, while others don't have a functioning campaign, volunteers, or resources. Vetting allows us an opportunity to build relationships with candidates and share more about Texas Eagle Forum. We are looking for hard working, informed candidates who have ideas and solutions but are also open to learning more about our key issues. I have vetted several inspiring deep thinkers, and I pray they win their primary and general elections.

Another important task we are working on as primary season approaches is gathering resolutions to help update our platform and inform our legislative priorities.
