



Texas Eagle Forum Priorities for the 88th Legislative Session

Stop the practice of “transgender medicine” in Texas: A child is not legally able to consent to treatments that will permanently harm his/her body and parents should not be able to order this bodily abuse either. This is our third session to ask for protection for our children. Pray our Legislators will understand that this has to be stopped.

Improve our Elections: Our elections are not transparent or simple. We must move to verifiable paper ballots which will greatly simplify elections. Current election “systems” are overly complicated, hackable, expensive, wrought with equipment failures, and are frustrating voters.

End Woke Education in Texas Public Schools: We cannot let our schools serve as indoctrination centers. They cannot be allowed to teach anti-biblical ideas to our children. They must return to teaching mastery of reading, writing, and mathematics along with knowledge of true history and science (aka Classical Education). Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) is destroying education and must not be used in Texas schools. No data on our students should ever be stored or shared outside of the student’s school files. Sexually inappropriate materials are educationally unsuitable for students. U.S., Texas, (ISD, city, county flags) only at public buildings/schools.

Fundamental Parental Rights: must be stated clearly in our Texas Constitution.

Medical Freedom: We will support laws that guarantee and protect our right to make our own medical decisions in Texas.

We will work **against any expansion of gambling or marijuana use in Texas**. We will also **oppose the deletion of the expiration of the Texas call for an Art. V Convention**.

Texas must ignore unconstitutional federal laws and mandates: We will support bills to abandon any action demanded by the Federal Government which is deemed unconstitutional by Texas.

Secure the Texas Electrical Grid: Our grid must be protected from the threat of EMP and enemy attacks.

Save 9 Resolution: We support a Resolution calling for a Constitutional Amendment Limiting the U.S. Supreme Court to 9 Justices.
